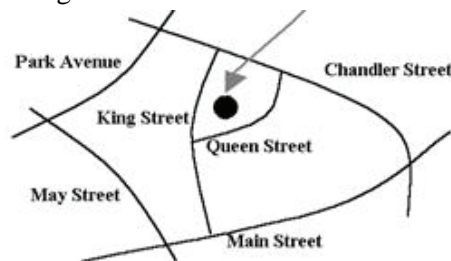

Family Health Center provides services for both individuals and families through the “family practice” model of care for both adults and children. At Family Health, the traditional idea of “the family doctor” has evolved into a 21st century medical practice that responds to the diversity of our American culture.

As a site for the University of Massachusetts Medical School Family Practice Residency Program since 1974, we are a nationally-recognized teaching facility and are one of the few medical residency programs in the country that is based in a community health center. In 2005, we expanded our teaching mission to include a dental residency program.

Family Health Center also operates four school health centers, three additional WIC sites and provides dental services in southern Worcester County.
